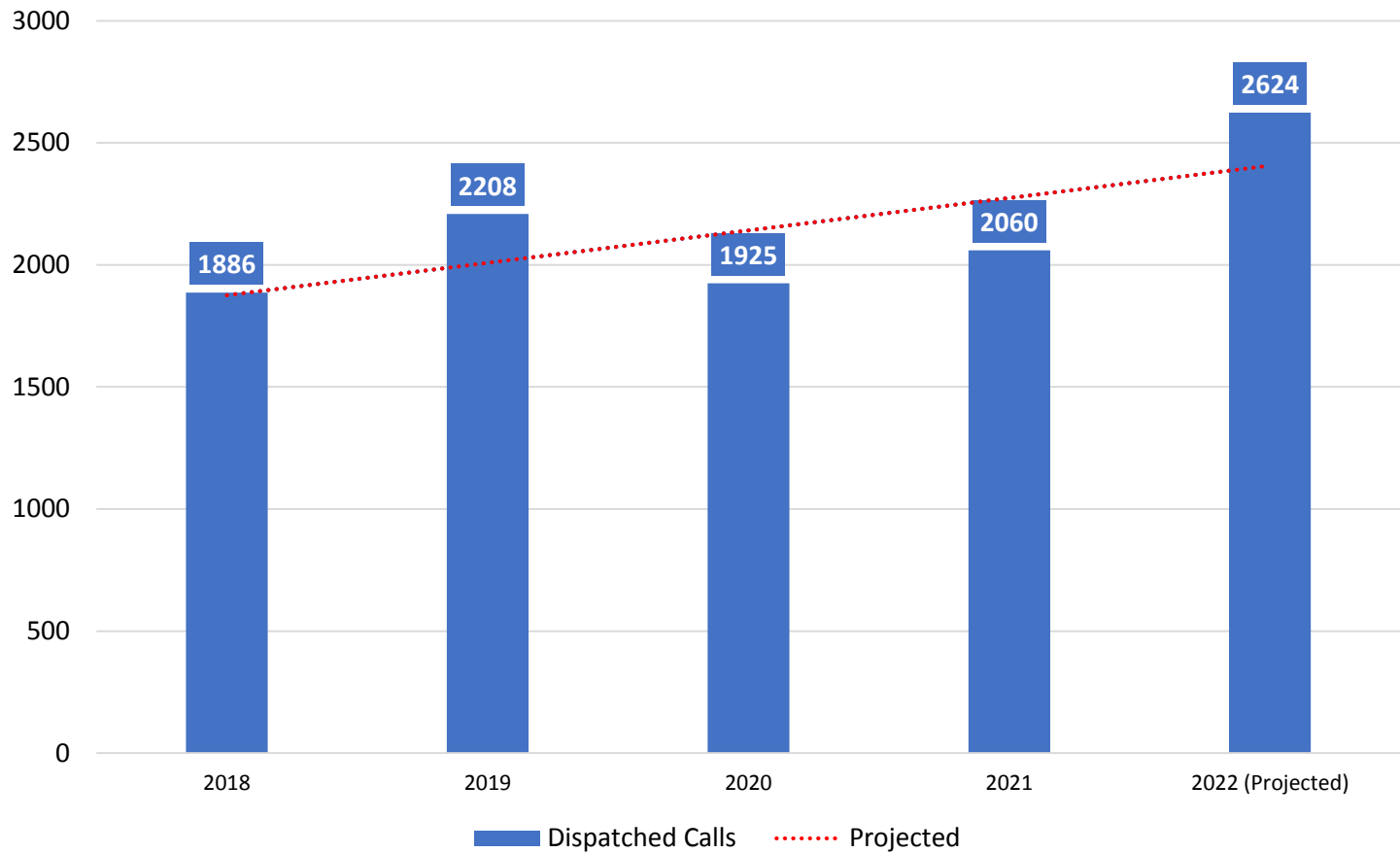

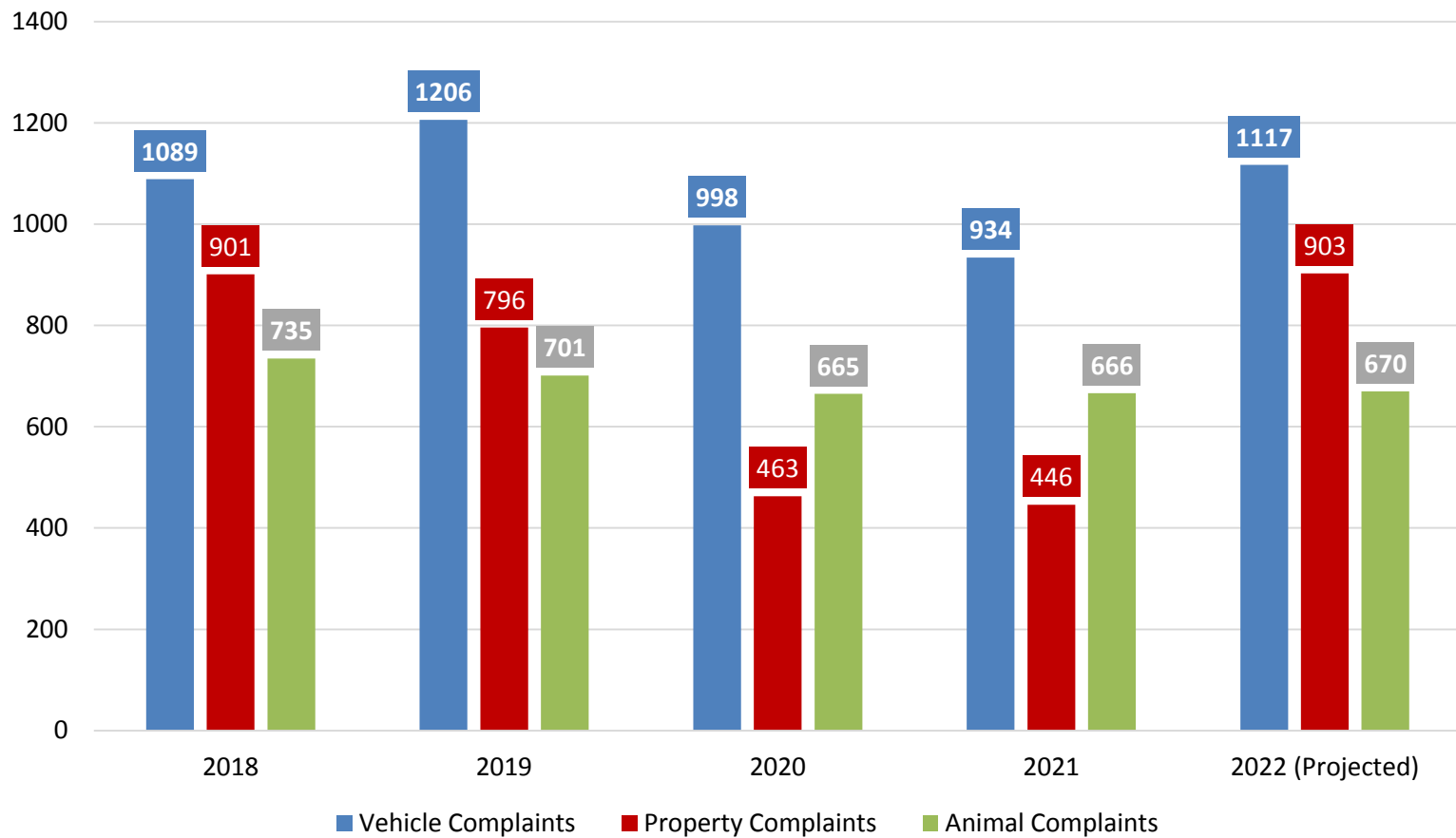

LES Update

CPO Traffic Unit

- Dedicated two-person unit which focuses on traffic enforcement and educational activities.
- Conducts Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections of commercial vehicles.
- Partners with Leduc RCMP General Duty on enforcement activities and check stops.
- Utilizes hot spot traffic areas based on:
 - complaints,
 - vulnerable road user areas and
 - collision data.

LES Key Initiatives – Loud Vehicles



- Project REV'N (Reduce Vehicle Excessive Noise) – Joint RCMP/LES project which targets loud vehicles.
- Monthly vehicle equipment check stops

LES Key Initiatives – Hot Spot Priorities (Updated Quarterly)



- General Duty
 - Downtown/Main Street
 - Foot/Bike patrol of City parks
 - Skatepark



- Traffic
 - All playground zones
 - Continue with Southfork for 40 km/hr Pilot
 - 50th Avenue/Discovery Way area for loud vehicles
