A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LEDUC IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE SPEED BYLAW

WHEREAS the *Traffic Safety Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter T-6, as amended, grants a municipality the authority to prescribe maximum speeds or minimum speeds of all or any part of any highway or roadway within the City of Leduc;

AND, in accordance with the Act, Council finds it desirable to amend Bylaw 846-2014 (the "Speed Bylaw");

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Leduc in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

- 1. The Speed Bylaw is hereby amended by:
 - i. replacing the preamble in PART III, Section 1 to read:

Maximum speed on all Highways shall be 40 kilometres per hour (km/hr) except as listed below and illustrated on Schedule A of this Bylaw.

- ii. adding the following new Section after the current PART III, Section 1. f):
 - 1.1 a) Maximum speed within designated School Zones and Playground Zones is 30km/h.
 - b) Designated School Zones are in effect as such between the hours of 7:30 am and 4:30 pm on school days.
- iii. replacing Schedule A with Appendix A to this Bylaw 1148-2023; and
- iv. renumbering Sections and Subsections as may be required for clarity.

EFFECTIVE DATE

2.	This Bylaw 1148-2023 shall take effect at 12:01am on August 28, 2023.
