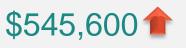

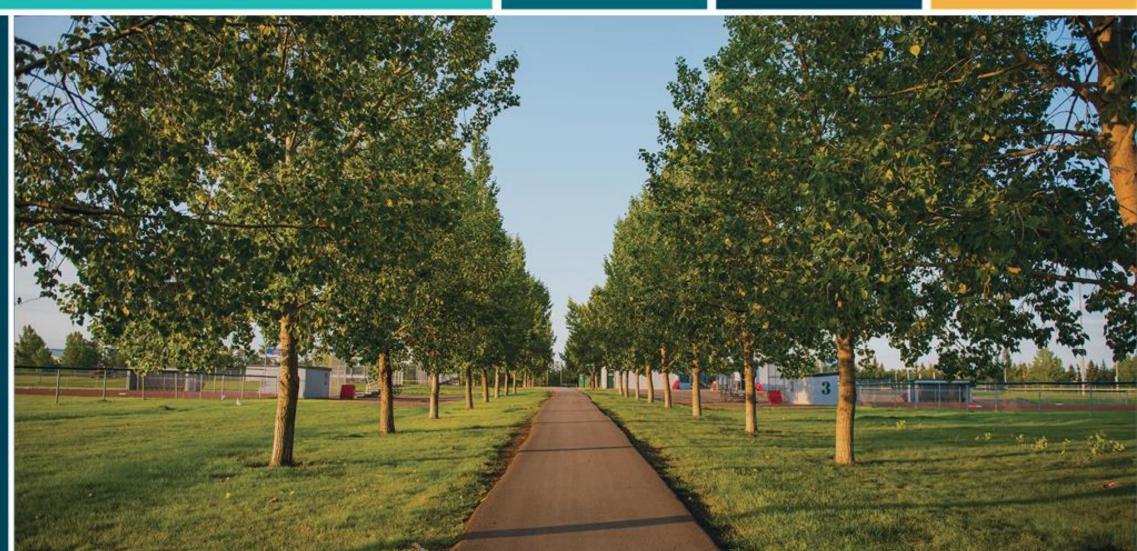

- Avoid Flushing Mainlines that are Clean
