

Engagement Responses




- Administration received 433 survey responses.
- The Deer Valley Gardens site received the most support for a temporary off-leash pilot.

Q7. If a temporary pop-up dog park were installed in one of the proposed neighborhoods. 1 = lowest support, 5 = highest support



Deer Valley Gardens




- 55% of respondents were in support of a temporary off-leash dog park in Deer Valley Gardens, 28% were not in support, and 13% were unsure of a temporary off-leash dog park.
- 51% of respondents would use a temporary off-leash dog park in Deer Valley Gardens, 36% of respondents would not use a temporary off-leash dog park and 13% were unsure.

Harry Bienert Park



- 51% of respondents were in support of a temporary off-leash dog park in Harry Bienert Park, 30% of respondents were not in support and 15% were unsure of a temporary off-leash dog park.
- 44% of respondents would use a temporary off-leash dog park in Harry Bienert Park, 39% would not use a temporary off-leash dog park and 17% were unsure.

Suntree Greenspace



- 46% of respondents were in support of a temporary off-leash dog park in Suntree Greenspace, 39% of respondents were not in support and 11% were unsure of a temporary off-leash dog park.
- 42% of respondents would use a temporary off-leash dog park in the Suntree Greenspace, 43% would not use a temporary offleash dog park and 15% were unsure.

Off-Leash Pilot Details

- The pilot site would be seasonal (May October).
- Fully enclosed with double gate entrances.
- Will include a waste receptacle and signage.
- Engagement will continue throughout the pilot.



City of Edmonton Pilot Update

The City of Edmonton (Edmonton) recently completed a pilot year of 27 temporary, fenced off-leash sites.

For the 27 sites, Edmonton Administration is recommending the following:

- 11 of the sites to be kept and maintained in the same state as was done so during the pilot;
- 8 of the sites be transitioned to ongoing, unfenced sites;
- 5 of the sites to be relocated to a different location within the neighborhoods with a different fence; and
- 3 of the sites to be removed completely and reassessed.
