REPORT TITLE: Bylaw No. 1168-2023 – Redistricting Leduc Business Park Stage 11 (2nd and 3rd

Readings)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Bylaw No. 1168-2023 will amend Bylaw No. 809-2013, Section 27.0 – Land Use Map, by redistricting part of the NE and SE ¼ Sections 1-50-25-W4 from UR – Urban Reserve to IM – Medium Industrial and US – Urban Services. The redistricting will allow for continued industrial development in the Leduc Business Park.

RECOMMENDATION

That Council give Bylaw No. 1168-2023 second reading.

That Council give Bylaw No. 1168-2023 third reading.

COUNCIL HISTORY

Council gave Bylaw No. 1168-2023 first reading on January 15, 2024.

BACKGROUND / RATIONALE

Bylaw No. 1168-2023 proposes to redistrict an area of undeveloped land in Leduc Business Park to facilitate continued medium industrial development in the area. This redistricting also includes a new storm water management facility which will service this stage along with future development on the remaining lands within the Leduc Business Park.

STRATEGIC / RELEVANT PLANS ALIGNMENT

The redistricting proposed is consistent with the City's Municipal Development Plan, as well as the North Leduc Industrial Area Structure Plan, Cathton-Farm Air Outline Plan, and Leduc Industrial Outline Plan. Copies of the land use concept plans from the relevant outline plans have been attached to this report for reference.

ORGANIZATIONAL IMPLICATIONS

ADMINISTRATION:

The redistricting of this land by Council is a condition of the subdivision approval previously issued for Leduc Business Park Stage 11. Should Council choose not to approve the redistricting of the lands as proposed within Bylaw No. 1168-2023, the City's Subdivision Authority will be unable to endorse the subdivision, prohibiting its registration and future development until the lands are appropriately zoned.
