
HOMELESS LEDUC

ABOUT HUB

Safe & supportive community to access critical social services with dignity

Between 2022 and 2023 we saw a 60% growth in demand



ABOUT HUB

Safe & responsible operations since 2009

Member of Homelessness Task Force, Leduc DBA, Chambers of Commerce

Serve homeless, at risk of homelessness, those needing socialization, seniors, those who are waiting on their first paycheck

CHALLENGE

HUB faces triple threat:

- 1. Expiring Permit
- 2. Lease expiry
- 3. No alternate location

Misconceptions and misinformation about our impact on community & safety have eroded support



CHALLENGE

On February 16, the HUB commences closure

If Leduc closes the doors on the HUB, it opens the gates to unsafe encampments
