• Within months, the Make-A-Wish Foundation was formed.

9 out of 10 wish kids reported that the wish experience relieved them from traumatic stress. Emotional & Mental Well-Being



9 out of 10 wish parents saw their child's emotional well-being improve

with a wish.

9 out of 10 medical providers

2024 Goals

- Raise \$105,000 (granting roughly 10 wishes)
- 16 teams & 300+ registered participants
 - Co-ed teams of 10-15 Players (age 18+) must raise \$5000 by game day. Player registration fee: \$50 & goes towards goal
 - Fans can register for free with no requirements and each team can have unlimited Fans

Onsite fun for all including; Home Run Derby & Base Running competitions, raffles, silent auction, local vendors, & onsite after party (rain out location: Canadian Brewhouse Leduc)

- Anticipating between 450-850 attendees
- Local focus for participants, partnerships, volunteers & sponsors
