OPTION 1: Status quo

OPTION 2: Overnight emergency shelter service only open during extreme cold weather

- **2.A** Protective Services Building, modular, externally (or internally) operated
- **2.B** Alexandra Pool, winterized changerooms, externally (or internally) operated
- 2.C Leased space, externally (or internally) operated

OPTION 3: Overnight emergency shelter service open nightly November 1 to April 30

- **3.A** Leased space, externally (or internally) operated
- **3.B** Protective Services Building , modular, externally (or internally) operated
- **3.C** Alexandra Pool, winterized changerooms, externally (or internally) operated

OPTION 4: Crisis Diversion Outreach Team, externally (or internally) operated

OPTION 5: Community Outreach Team, internally operated

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT OPTIONS

- Legislative Requirements Only: engagement will only be used for those options requiring public hearings.
- Post-Decision: engagement will only be used to help inform mitigation strategies related to implementation of the option already decided by Council.
- Pre-Decision: engagement will only be used for the option being considered by Council to help inform Council's final decision.
