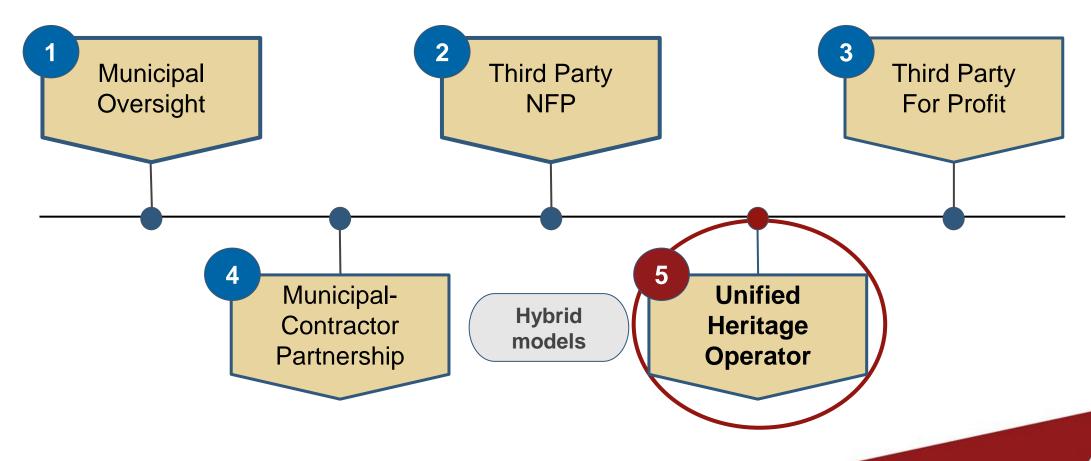

## **Operations & Cost Analysis: 5 Models**





### Why a Unified Heritage Operator?

#### 1. Data:

Scoring positions this hybrid model as the most robust.

#### 2. Community-supported:

Aligns with a key recommendation of community and partner engagement.

#### 3. This model <u>balances</u>:

- financial sustainability
- preservation consistency
- strategic oversight

#### **Advantages:**

- Scalability
- Resource efficiency
- Reduces duplication across sites
- Fosters innovation in programming and community engagement

#### **Challenges:**

- Some governance complexity
- Limitations on grassroots engagement



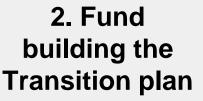
### **Next Steps:** MOVING FORWARD in 2025
