AMENDMENT #179

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LEDUC IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW NO. 809-2013 BY REDISTRICTING LAND.

The *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended (the "Act"), grants a municipality the authority to pass a Land Use Bylaw;

AND, in accordance with the Act, the City of Leduc passed Land Use Bylaw No. 809-2013 to regulate and control the use and development of land and buildings in the City of Leduc, and the Council has deemed it expedient and necessary to amend Bylaw No. 809-2013;

AND, in accordance with the Act, notice of intention to pass this bylaw has been given and a public hearing has been held;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Leduc in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Bylaw No. 809-2013, the Land Use Bylaw, is amended by Bylaw No. 1217-2025.
- 2. The Land Use Map, attached to and being part of Bylaw No. 809-2013, is amended by reclassifying the following lands:

Part SW & SE ¼ of Section 24-49-25-W4 (consisting of 3.32 ha more or less)

From UR – Urban Reserve, to GR – General Recreation, RNL – Residential Narrow Lot, and RCD – Residential Compact Development, as shown in Schedule A, attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw No. 1217-2025.
