AMENDMENT #178

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LEDUC IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW NO. 809-2013 BY REDISTRICTING LAND.

The *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, grants a municipality the authority to pass a Land Use Bylaw;

AND, in accordance with the Act, the City of Leduc passed Land Use Bylaw No. 809-2013 to regulate and control the use and development of land and buildings in the City of Leduc, and the Council has deemed it expedient and necessary to amend Bylaw No. 809-2013;

AND, in accordance with the Act, notice of intention to pass this bylaw has been given and a public hearing has been held;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Leduc in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Bylaw No. 809-2013, the Land Use Bylaw, is amended by Bylaw No. 1215-2025.
- 2. That the Land Use Map, attached to and being part of the Land Use Bylaw of the City of Leduc, is amended by reclassifying the following lands (consisting of 8.852 ha more or less):
 - Part of Lot 9, Block 21, Plan 1020516;
 - Part of Lot 10, Block 21, Plan 1020517;
 - Part of Lot 4MR, Block 21, Plan 1321360;
 - Part of Lot 1MR, Block 21, Plan 9021045; and
 - Lot 2PUL, Block 21, Plan 9021045.

From UR – Urban Reserve, to RCD – Residential Compact Development, MUR – Mixed-Use Residential, GR – General Recreation, and US – Urban Services, as shown in Schedule A, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
