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

## **Our Goal**

- Build Youth Centered Space for Leduc
- Provide opportunities for youth to develop stronger community connection and resilience.
- Foster belonging, safety, skill-building, leadership and mentorship for local youth.

# Key Milestones Achieved

We've worked in collaboration with City officials and have outlined conceptualized plans.

- Toured Youth Centers in action in region and learned from other Clubs and organizations what is idea for youth centered space.
- Scott Builders provided, probono a high level budget, Scope of Work with conservative estimates, and first round renderings of what this building could be!
- Found a plot of City Land that checks all of the key points for this project.
- BGC Leduc shared the cost with the City to complete a full topo Level D assessment, completed by Al-Terra who quantified a high-level summary of what earth work could look like.




## The Opportunity


# Phase One – Partner with City (Spring 2025)



### Phase One:

- \$60 000 be reallocated from Budget 2025 to explore further Geotech investigation, site surveying and design.
- Memorandum of Understanding and Land Use Agreement with City
- Collect further youth and community input to make sure this is reflective of our community needs.

# Phase 2 – Finalize Design (Fall 2025)



- Work with City and Design team to finalize plans.
- Prepare design to go to market for tender (City to lead)

## Phase 3 – Raise Capital

(Fall 2025 – Spring 2026)

- Collaborate with City to complete a grant application for the following key grants:
- -Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP)
- -Canada Community Building Fund (CCBF)
- Donation-Based Crowd Funding
- Corporate Partnerships
- Fundraising Events



## Phase 4 – Award and Begin Construction (Spring 2026)



#### **Key Milestones:**

- Secure building permit and construction tender award
- Finalize contracts with contractors and project manager
- Begin site preparation and construction

#### Dependencies:

- Phase 3 design completion (Fall 2025)
- Final fundraising milestones and grant approvals
- Confirmation of naming rights, community support, and operational readiness


#### **Our Vision Realized:**

- Investing in Resilience: This investment empowers Leduc's youth to become:

- A Brighter, More Resilient Tomorrow: By investing now, we foster a future that is stronger, safer, and more vibrant—for youth and the broader Leduc community alike.
- Aligned with the City of Leduc's Vision: This project directly supports the City's goals for community well-being, long-term sustainability, and active civic engagement.

## Let's Launch Phase One Together:

Our Key Actions to Initiate

#### **City of Leduc Contributions:**

- Financial Investment: Reallocate \$60,000 from the 2025 Budget to fund essential preliminary work:
- In-depth Geotechnical Investigation
- Comprehensive Site Surveying
- Further Design Exploration

#### **BGC Leduc Contributions:**

Community-Driven Design: Lead the effort in actively collecting further youth and broader community input to ensure the final Youth Centre design truly reflects the needs and aspirations of Leduc.

Future Sustainability: Undertake further fund development initiatives and planning to secure further capital for project.

## Shared Contributions (City of Leduc & BGC Leduc):

Formal Agreement: Establish a clear framework for our collaboration through a joint Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and Land Use Agreement as soon as possible.
